

CENTRAL PEEL SECONDARY SCHOOL MODEL UNITED NATIONS XI

CPSSMUN XI Protocol and Code of Conduct

- Acknowledging the <u>Peel Code of Conduct</u>, which outlines the behaviours that all students participating, regardless of their school, must uphold,
- Acknowledging that Central Peel Secondary School is on the traditional territory of the Mississauga's of the Credit First Nations and that we all have a responsibility to recognize such,
- *Emphasizing* that participation in Central Peel Model United Nations (CPSSMUN) activities is a privilege for students:
- CPSSMUN Expects that all delegates in the delegations and whom may attend any of the Model UN conferences hosted or attended by Central Peel Secondary School:
 - 1. Respect each other by
 - a. Encouraging other delegates. No berating will be tolerated in and outside of CPSSMUN conferences.
 - b. Acting in a responsible way to CPSS delegates as well as to other delegates outside of the school.
 - 2. Consider the work of all delegates in a mindful way. No plagiarism is ever acceptable including:
 - a. Claiming others' ideas as your own.
 - b. Removing delegate's names from directives or making amendments without their knowledge.
 - c. Deleting clauses without the approval of all sponsors.
 - d. Or all other violations of academic integrity within Model UN
 - 3. Are mindful of the commitment that their fellow delegates and the organizers of the conference have put into hosting the event, and:
 - a. Avoid cancelling attendance at a conference at short notice
 - i. If you are no longer able to attend a conference, inform any member of the Secretariat or a staff supervisor as soon as possible
 - ii. In the event that unforeseen events (such as personal emergencies) occur, this will be excused
 - b. Respect committee resources as well as committee time
 - i. This includes taking breaks at the designated times and not withholding resources with other delegates
 - 4. Expects that delegates are respectful of designated break time, and comply with the conference's policy of work outside of conference hours, especially if it is prohibited,
 - a. This is to ensure that all delegates are afforded equal opportunity

- 5. Mandates all delegates to restrain from using technology, ChatGPT, or any other miscellaneous AI platforms during the committee or in any relation to your committee (i.e. working papers, speeches, position papers etc.)
 - a. Failure to abide by this regulation can lead to the removal of award contention or the possibility of being removed from the conference based on the extent to which the resource was utilized
- 6. Requires all delegates to act equitable and fair with each other, staff and other delegations
 - a. In the occasion that a delegate violates this code, they can be subject to any of the following repercussions: being removed from the conference, being out of award contention, removable from the delegation, or any similar punishment that can be decided on
