Code of Conduct & COVID 19 Protocol

Acknowledges the Peel Code of Conduct which outlines the behaviors that all students participating, regardless of their school, must uphold,

Recognizes that Central Peel Secondary School is on the traditional territory of the Mississauga's of the Credit First Nations and that we all have a responsibility to recognize such,

CPSSMUN Expects that all delegates in the delegations and whom may attend any of the Model UN conferences hosted or attended by Central Peel Secondary School:

- 1. Following Peel School COVID 19 protocols as well as:
 - a. Conducting a self-screening prior to attending. Link to the Ontario self-screening is here.
 - b. While no longer mandatory we strongly recommended masking for all indoor spaces, but all delegates are expected to respect each other's decision to wear or not wear a mask. Under NO circumstances will harassment be tolerated.
 - c. Students and staff who test positive for COVID-19 will continue to self-isolate for 5 days if fully vaccinated and 10 days if not.
 - d. Informing Secretariat, staff, and faculty advisors if COVID 19 symptoms develop during the conference.
- 2. Respect each other by
 - a. Acting responsible and mindful of all delegates and staff members.
 - b. Considering the work of all delegates in a mindful way. No plagiarism is ever acceptable including claiming others' ideas as your own, removing delegate's names from directives or making amendments without their knowledge, deleting clauses without the approval of all sponsors, pre-writing clauses or whole resolutions/directives is prohibited, or all other violations of academic integrity within Model UN.
- 3. Expects that delegates are respectful of committee session times.
 - a. This includes taking breaks at the designated times and not withholding resources with other delegates.
- 4. Participants are kindly requested to refrain from utilizing electronic devices and AI platforms during committee sessions
 - a. Please refrain from using your devices during committee sessions to research, write resolution papers, or generate speeches.

- b. General Assemblies are permitted to use their devices during committee sessions. However, all delegates, regardless of their committee, must not reference any AI platforms to aid in any form throughout the conference.
- 5. Requires all delegates to act equitable and fair with each other, staff and other delegations.
 - a. In the event that a delegate violates this code, they can be subject to any of the following repercussions: being removed from the conference, being out of award contention, removable from the delegation.
